

Our Services

Counseling & Treatment

Inpatient:

- Medical detox from drugs & alcohol
- Residential programs for both men and women

Outpatient:

- Mental health counseling
- Medication assisted treatment (MAT)
- Psych medication management

Transportation

We partnered with Lyft to provide free rides to treatment at all of our facilities. For local clients, On Demand's drivers will provide rides to and from treatment, if needed. On Demand will also provide rides to those who obtain jobs through our staffing services.

Medical Services

On Demand Counseling is an affiliate of On Demand Occupational Medicine (ODOM). ODOM provides:

- Primary & immediate care services
- Pharmacy onsite
- Drug & alcohol testing
- Vaccinations
- X-ray services

How It Works

The Assessment

Our mental health professionals will meet with clients to provide full assessments of any medical concerns and mental health needs.

The Plan

Clients will work with their case managers to establish a medical plan that fits their needs.

The Treatment

Case managers adjust treatment levels and concerns as the client moves through the established treatment plan. Clients can participate in any and all parts of the New Day Recovery/On Demand Counseling continuum as needed. Counselors support clients in every step of the recovery journey.

- Communication with legal entities
- Finding safe housing

- Ensuring that all appropriate parties are notified of progress and issues
